Anarthrous attributive, post position	noun - adjective		ἄλλος μεθιτηρῆς	another disciple	
Anarthrous attributive, pre-position	adjective - noun	style or adjective emphasis	ὄλω τῷ οἴκῳ	with <i>his</i> entire house	attributive sense
Anarthrous attributive, irregular adj.	adjective - article - noun		ὁ λόγος ἀγαθός	The word <i>is</i> good	Sometimes being verb is implied

Adverbial	verb - adjective (also adj - verb?)				

Most adjectives are post position

Meanings

articular	with the article
anarthrous	without the article
attributive	assigns a quality to the noun modified - "the good word"
predicate	an adj or noun makes an assertion about the substantive - "the word is good"
substantive	noun has the article, not the adjective functions as noun - " the good [man]"
adverbial	functions as adverb
post position/ post positive	following a word
pre-position/prepositive	preceding a word
object complement	a second accusative making an assertion about the direct object noun /pronoun
